## **CORONAVIRUS / COVID-19 INFORMATION**

Dear Parents/Carers

Happisburgh Primary School will be closed next week to all but the children of key workers and children classed as 'vulnerable.'

Key workers work within the following sectors:

- **Health and Social Care** - doctors, nurses, midwives, paramedics, social workers, care workers, producers and distributors of medicines and medical and personal protective equipment.
- **Education and Childcare** - teaching staff, social workers and those specialist education professionals
- **Key Public Services** - justice system, religious staff, charities and workers delivering key frontline services, funeral directors and journalists and broadcasters.
- **Local and National Government** – including benefit administrators
- **Food and Necessary Goods** - food production, processing, distribution, sale and delivery, including hygienic and veterinary medicines
- **Public safety and national security** - police and support staff, Ministry of Defence civilians, contractor and armed forces personnel, fire and rescue services, National Crime Agency staff, border security, prison and probation staff
- **Transport** - air, water, road and rail operators,
- **Utilities, communication and financial services** - workers in banks, building societies and financial markets, oil, gas, electricity and water sectors (including sewerage), information technology and data infrastructure sector, civil nuclear, chemicals, telecommunications (including but not limited to network operations, field engineering, call centre staff, postal services and delivery, payments providers and waste disposal sectors.

If one or more members of your immediate family fit into one of these categories, you can ask for your child to attend school. Should staffing ratios become a problem in the future, priority will be given to children where both parents are key workers. Should the school be unable to open, children may be given a place in another school in the locality.

Children who have a social worker or who have an Education Health Care Plan will also be given priority.

In all cases, your child should stay at home wherever possible to limit the spread of COVID-19.
