This week, we are sending home a parents' version of our Recovery Plan. We feel the children have now settled into our new routines and are working well in their lessons. The teachers have been busy gathering Assessment Data and identifying any gaps in learning and we now feel we have a clear idea of the interventions that will support the children's educational development.

We are expecting to receive a Government Grant over the next few weeks, which will support us in filling these gaps in learning, and making sure that the children are once again working at or above age-expected levels. With the money we receive, we hope to be able to buy in extra teaching support and also to invest in additional resources and high-quality intervention packages.

Free School Meals (FSM) Food Parcels

We have been working with Stalham High School, who provide our catering contract, to explore the best possible arrangements where food parcels are needed, for example when a pupils who is eligible for benefits-related free school meals and who is not in attendance because they:

- are self-isolating
- have had symptoms or a positive test result themselves
- are a close contact of someone who has coronavirus (COVID-19)
- are not attending as a result of local lockdown arrangements

250 gm block of cheese

5 x apples

1 x loaf of bread

5 cakes/tray bakes

10 portions sunflower spread
