Reading Karate Expectations

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Foundation Stage</u></p> <p>Sharing a book with an adult at home counts as a read. This could be your school reading book, library book or a bedtime story. An adult must sign your reading record. Only one read per day counts.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Year 1 and 2</u></p> <p>Sharing a book with an adult at home for 10 minutes or more counts as a read. This could be your school reading book, library book or a book from home. An adult must sign your reading record book. Only one read per day counts.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Year 3 and 4</u></p> <p>Sharing a book with an adult at home for at least 15 minutes counts as a read. This could be your school reading book, library book or a book from home. An adult must sign your reading record book. Only one read per day counts. If you are a free reader, you can read to yourself but an adult must sign for it to count as a read.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Years 5 and 6</u></p> <p>Sharing a book with an adult at home or reading to yourself for at least 20 minutes counts as a read. You could read your school reading book, library book or a book from home. Remember to write a comment about what you have just read. An adult must sign your reading record book. Only one read per day counts.</p>
